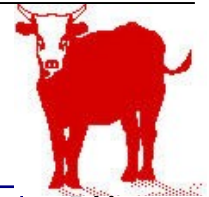

Events & Notes

Early Shema—The end of the time to say Shema on Shabbat morning is before we reach it in the normal course of davening between now and the end of July. Please remember to say the Shema early.

Fast of 17 Tammuz—The fast day, and the beginning of the 3 weeks, occurs on Thursday, July 2nd. Note changes in the davening schedule. The fast begins at 4:24 AM and ends after 9:13 PM.

July 4th Observed—Independence Day is observed on Friday, July 3rd, so morning davening is delayed until 7:30 that day.

Survey / Survey Meetings—All EDOS community members should have received (filled out and returned) a survey, which is to be followed up by a series of town all meetings. If you haven't attended one of the meetings, please join the board for the last meeting, Sunday Morning, June 28th, at 8:15 AM to discuss the survey findings and engage in feedback to guide the future of EDOS.

Semiannual Meeting—Our summer meeting takes place after Shacharit, about 8:15 AM, on Sunday, July 12th.
